

Degree Scholarships for Year 13 Students

The Year 13 Degree Study Grant will be available to every Hawke's Bay Year 13 Secondary School graduate commencing degree study at EIT in February each year.

- 100% FREE tuition fee for Year One.
- 50% FREE tuition fee for Year Two (subject to applicants meeting agreed standards).

Note: Fees that are the responsibility of the student are: Students' Association, Course Related Costs, and any extra courses over the equivalent of full-time study.

Applicants must:

- Undertake full-time degree study at EIT in programmes commencing in February 2012.
- Be a 2011 Year 13 graduate from a secondary school in the Hawke's Bay region from Dannevirke to Gisborne, and Taupo.
- Meet the EIT Year 13 degree entry criteria to be eligible.
- Be a New Zealand resident.

The Margaret Hetley Scholarship

The Margaret Hetley Scholarship was established to assist women to undertake tertiary study and to commemorate the centennial year of the women's suffrage movement. It was named in memory of Mrs Margaret Hetley who gifted the EIT campus to the Hawke's Bay community.

Who can apply

The scholarship is for all female students enrolling at EIT Hawke's Bay directly from secondary school in a certificate or diploma programme. It will be awarded on the basis of qualities and attributes that would enable them to succeed and possibly staircase into higher academic programmes in the future.

Details of the scholarship are as follows:

1. Scholarship Funding Details:

An amount of \$1,750 will be available to be granted as fee support for a single student in their first year of study at EIT.

Payment of the scholarship will be made by Otatara Trust Inc. directly to the Eastern Institute of Technology Registry Office in part payment of the successful applicant's course fees.

Payment is conditional on the applicant completing the enrolment process at EIT.

2. Criteria:

Applicants must:

- have completed five years secondary school, be a year 11 graduate and a 2011 graduate from a Hawke's Bay Secondary School.
- be intending to undertake their first year of tertiary study in an EIT Hawke's Bay Certificate or Diploma Programme in 2012.
- be able to prove academic achievement through most recent academic results.
- provide two references - at least one from their current secondary school relevant to their current academic achievement (Year 13 - 7th Form) and/ or one other reference relevant to their personal achievement.
- provide the names of two referees whom the panel can contact.
- provide evidence of a brief, realistic career path.

3. Decisions:

The granting of the scholarship will be assessed by a panel comprising of:

- a Students' Association Representative.
- at least two other people appointed by the Chief Executive.

The panel's decision will not be contestable.

4. Conditions of the Scholarship:

- The Scholarship Panel has absolute discretion to determine the allocation of grants and their decision is not contestable.
- Any grant awarded will only become payable upon the confirmed enrolment of the applicant in the course of study indicated in their application.
- If it is subsequently found that any information provided in the application was false the applicant shall be required to refund the grant paid.
- If the successful scholarship recipient withdraws or is expelled from their programme of study they will be required to refund the grant paid unless special dispensation is granted by EIT's Chief Executive and the Selection Panel.

5. Application Process

Applications will be called for as follows:

- By providing information with Prospectus and scholarship information to prospective students individually and through schools, other agencies and community groups.
- By announcement through media as appropriate.

Application forms are available from EIT Hawke's Bay Taradale campus or centres in Hastings, Flaxmere and Waipukurau, and local high schools

Applications close on 31 January each year and applicants will be advised of the outcome by 17 February 2012.
