This scholarship is for those students who are accepted onto the Certificate in Grapegrowing and Winemaking at EIT Tairāwhiti. Each award is a \$2000 contribution towards the cost of tuition fees for one full year.

The numbers of Scholarships are limited. All applications received by the due date will be considered. Applications close on Friday 8 July 2016 for the programme start date of 1 August.

This is an open entry scholarship. All completed, well presented submissions will be considered. Additional support material is welcome and can make a significant difference to the decision making process.

Entry Criteria

1. Applicant is able to express in writing their motivation for working in the wine or viticulture industries, including where they see their future career path, and what opportunity they would like to create for themselves in this industry – this must be supplied as a cover letter of a minimum of 250 words.
2. Application is supported by two letters of endorsement from members of the community (not a family member) who can endorse the applicant via both personal and past work experience or secondary school references, and can also provide a verbal reference if required to support this application. Please ensure contact details are included with the letter. References are confidential to EIT.
3. Enrolled in the EIT Tairāwhiti Campus Certificate in Winemaking and Grapegrowing and Winemaking level 4 full year programme. An application to enrol in this programme may be submitted at the same time as your application for this Scholarship.
