What is the Pharazyn Scholarship?

The Ōtātara Trust has received a bequest from the Pharazyn Estate to be used for the benefit of students in the Bachelor of Teaching (Early Childhood Education) at EIT.

As a result, Ōtātara Trust are instituting a new scholarship, which will be offered annually from 2017. The scholarship recipient will be selected by the Ōtātara Trust scholarships committee using the guidelines in the application.

The scholarship will be at least \$2000.

- To recognise contribution to community
- To encourage learning at all stages of life
- To encourage completion of studies
- To diminish barriers to learning

Who May Apply?

- Any full-time student about to begin year 3 (Level 7) who has been enrolled in the Bachelor of Teaching (Early Childhood Education) with EIT since their first year (Level 5).
