### NEW ZEALAND CERTIFICATES IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE (NZCEL)

Develop your language knowledge and improve your skills with the New Zealand Certificates in English Language (NZCEL) programmes. These are designed to help you at your own specific level, to gain confidence and to help you "live the language". You will:

- Practical and academic English skills.
- Widen your vocabulary knowledge.
- Learn how to communicate with people in a variety of situations.

Successful completion of NZCEL Levels 3, 4 and 5 offers an academic pathway to further study at EIT or any other New Zealand tertiary provider. You will also receive a New Zealand recognised certificate.

### ENGLISH LANGUAGE SHORT COURSES

Short courses can be used for personal development such as helping you communicate better while you live in New Zealand or to help you get a better job in your home country.

Students who choose to study General English can be at any level and will learn alongside NZCEL students.

**Note:** Sometimes a student takes General English for a few weeks before joining the NZCEL programme.

### IELTS PREPARATION CLASSES

Widen your vocabulary and improve world knowledge. IELTS preparation classes are offered as an extension for students on NZCEL Level 3 to 5 programmes. You will spend four hours per week on developing specific skills with aim to prepare students for the IELTS test. Day time or evening classes are available. Subject areas covered are:

- Reading
- Writing
- Listening and speaking
- Vocabulary development
- Test taking strategies

**Entry Requirements:** Most appropriate for students in NZCEL Level 3 or higher, or equivalent proficiency level.

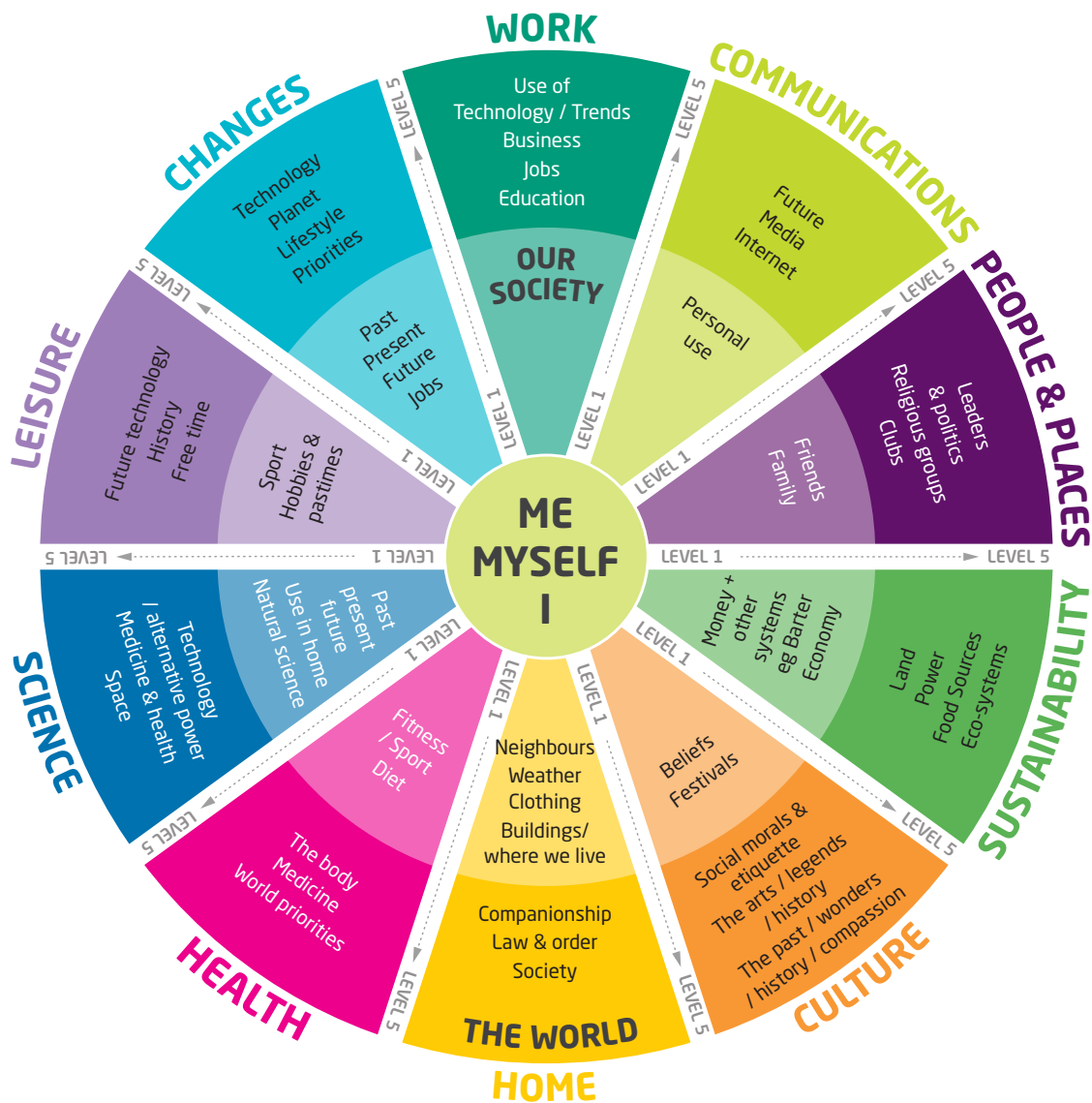

## TYPICAL TIMETABLE FOR FULL TIME STUDY

This is a typical timetable for students studying the NZCEL or the English Language Training Scheme. The timetable offers a balance of core English language class time with practical extension sessions and time for self-study. In addition to this structured learning approach, students will have the opportunity to learn English outside the classroom while participating in class outings and trips to other places in New Zealand.

**Study hours:** 20 hours with a teacher and 17 hours of independent study. This equates to 37 hours a week of learning.
