

Year 13 Degree Scholarship application

This scholarship is for Year 13 students who are applying to study a degree at EIT. Each scholarship is for the cost of tuition fees for one year of degree study. For those who are approved for the government fees free policy, this will cover their second year of study.

Scholarships for the Bachelor of Māori Visual Arts (Te Toi o Ngā Rangi), the Bachelor of Viticulture, the Bachelor of Wine Science and the Viticulture/Wine Science concurrent degree are open to students nationwide.

Charges that the student is responsible for include the student services levy and fees for any extra courses over and above the equivalent of full-time study.

All complete and well presented submissions will be considered. Additional support material is welcome.

APPLICANTS MUST:

- Be a Year 13 student from Hawke's Bay or Tairāwhiti (Hick's Bay to Taupo and Dannevirke).
- Meet the degree entry criteria and be accepted to undertake full-time degree study at EIT in February 2019.
- Be a New Zealand Citizen or Permanent Resident.
- Complete the form overleaf.
- Include all supporting documents.

For the scholarship to cover second year fees applicants must also:

- Pass at least 75% of their Year 1 courses.
- Undertake their second year of full-time degree study in February 2020.
- Meet all programme requirements for advancement to the second year of their degree.

EIT will select recipients taking into account the following:

- Application quality and completeness.
- Enquiries made about the applicant with referees and other appropriate people eg. employers, schools, community leaders.
- Other information which may be available and relevant.

In addition, some programmes may choose to interview applicants.

Applicants will be notified by mid November.

Some programmes may allow for later application, however this is an exception.

Please note: You do not need to wait until you have your NCEA L3 results to apply.

WHAT TO INCLUDE WITH THIS APPLICATION FORM

1. A cover letter with a minimum of 250 words.

This must express your motivation for working in your chosen study area, including where you see your future career path, and what opportunity you would like to create for yourself in this industry.

2. A letter of endorsement from your high school *except* if you are applying for the Bachelor of Teaching (Primary) the School Report form in the programme application pack replaces the high school endorsement letter.
3. An additional letter from a member of the community (not a family member) who can endorse you personally or from past work experience, and can provide a verbal reference if required (please ensure contact details are included with the letter). *Except* if you are applying for the Bachelor of Teaching (Primary), Bachelor of Teaching (Early Childhood), Bachelor of Social Work or Bachelor of Nursing, where one of the referee reports in the programme application pack replaces the community endorsement letter. References are confidential to EIT.
4. Enclose your NCEA results for Level 1, 2 and 3 credits to date. (Please note you do not need to wait until you have your NCEA L3 results to apply).
5. Enclose your enrolment form for a degree at EIT to commence full-time study in February 2019.
6. Please ensure that any additional forms in the programme application pack have been fully completed and returned to EIT by 1 October.

HOW TO ENROL FOR YOUR CHOSEN DEGREE

STEP 1

Check out eit.ac.nz to find out more about the programmes we offer and to enrol online.

You can also request a printed enrolment pack online or by calling us.

You can apply to StudyLink now if you need help to pay any fees, course related costs or living costs. You can do this even if you haven't been accepted on to your programme yet.

Visit www.studylink.govt.nz to apply.

You should also check your free fee eligibility with your NSN number at feesfree.govt.nz

STEP 2

If you apply online you will be sent a form to check, sign and return to EIT along with any required supporting documents.

If you are applying by paper enrolment form, you will need to complete this and send back to EIT with any required supporting documents.

STEP 3

You will receive conditional acceptance pending your final NCEA results, unless you have already achieved the entry requirements at the time of applying. At the time of final acceptance you will be contacted with programme information including your start date. You may also receive course selection forms. You need to complete these quickly and return them to us so we can finalise your enrolment.

If you do not send these back to us we are not able to give Studylink the information they need to finalise your student finance.

STEP 4

You will receive an invoice with payment details. You must arrange for full payment of your enrolment fees before the start of your programme.
