Who's this for?

Students must be enrolled in the Master of Health Science programme (180 credits). Students must complete 90 credits at Level 8 and a 90 credit research thesis at Level 9.

What does it cover?

This scholarship covers the full fee (domestic student) for the research thesis course. This will allow a high-achieving student to carry out a research project utilising the state-of-the-art research facilities at the EIT ISH.

Eligibility Criteria and Application Details

- 1. Applicants for the Scholarships must enrol in the programme of a Master of Health Science at EIT via the research pathway. They must be enrolled in the Masterate Research Thesis course (MN9.490) or other 90 credit research thesis.
- 2. At the time of application, applicants must:
 - Have achieved a grade average of A- or above (or with Distinction) in the last year of a Degree, or hold a
 Postgraduate Diploma or an Honours degree at Level 8 from EIT or another New Zealand tertiary education
 provider.
- 3. New Zealand citizens and permanent residents are eligible to apply.
- 4. Applicants must complete the prescribed application form and must include the following:
 - a. A verified copy of their Academic Transcript.
 - b. A verified copy of the application to enrol into a Postgraduate programme.
 - c. A written statement by the applicant (200 words maximum) on how this Scholarship will assist the applicant in furthering their study and career.
 - d. A brief description of the topic of research they will investigate in the thesis paper.
 - e. A recent, named photo.

The information requested in this application form will be used solely for the purposes of assessing your application for the scholarship. Personal information contained in your application will be made available to members of the Selection Panel.

EIT undertakes to store your application in a secure place in the event that you are successful in gaining the Scholarship. You have the right to have access and correct the information provided to EIT.
