



## 2022 TE KUPENGA ENTRY CRITERIA

- Applicant must be currently enrolled at kura/school as a Year 13 student
- Applicant must complete and return Registration and Student Profile forms
- If requested, selected students will be required to attend a zoom interview.
- Submissions are limited to one artwork per tauira/student
- Artwork must be based on the kaupapa/theme: Te Ao Hou
- Artwork cannot exceed 1m x 1m
- Artwork can be made using the medium/s of your choice
- ALL artwork submissions must be delivered to Toihoukura by October 20, 2022.
- Return delivery costs of artwork is the responsibility of the applicant
- Applicant must qualify for Fees Free and EIT Year 13 Scholarship.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Recipients of Te Kupenga 2022 will be announced at the exhibition opening (Thursday 27th October 2022)
- Applicants need to complete and return a registration form and a student profile form
- All submissions need to be delivered to Toihoukura no later than 3pm October 20, 2022
- *Te Kupenga* will be on display from October 20, 2022 to November 9, 2022.
- Shipping of works, to and from Toihoukura, is the responsibility of the applicant or school
- Toihoukura will take full responsibility for curation
- Works for sale will be priced accordingly by senior staff of Toihoukura
- There is no commission for sold works
- The exhibition opening will be a public event
- Toihoukura will host an information session following the opening
- Images of applicants and/or submissions may be used for marketing
- Scholarship does not include accommodation
