Scholarship

The Te Toka Māori and Pasifika Trades Training scholarship is an initiative to “ensure more Māori and Pasifika learners, aged 16-40, can obtain meaningful trades skills/qualifications and apprenticeships. The scholarship **covers programme fees** (and where practical, course related costs).

Who can apply

All interested applicants must be of Māori and/or Pasifika descent; be 16-40 years of age at the start of their study; be a New Zealand citizen or New Zealand permanent resident; and be able to meet the entry requirements for the qualification they are enrolling in.

How to apply

- All interested applicants must complete an **APPLICATION TO ENROL** form for a chosen trade qualification at EIT | Te Pūkenga Tairāwhiti.
- All interested applicants must complete this **Scholarship Application** form.
- Deliver all **Application to Enrol** and **Scholarship Application** forms to the **Main Office, at EIT | Te Pūkenga Tairāwhiti Campus, 290 Palmerston Road, Gisborne.**

Selection Criteria

Applicants will be chosen for the scholarship because they:

- Show a genuine desire to succeed in their chosen trades qualification;
- Are committed to completing the practical and theory parts of their qualification;
- Are committed to a pathway toward the completion of a Level 4 qualification;
- Are keen to secure an apprenticeship and or employment opportunity in one of the trade industries which these qualifications prepares them for; and
- Have a commitment to Ngati Porou, hapu/iwi and or Pasifika workforce development;
- Have a commitment to being a positive contributor to the Te Toka whānau, including embracing whanaungatanga and manaakitanga;
- Have a commitment to Te Toka related programmes, including attendance at regular noho marae, wananga and other tailored programmes including a personal E-passport.

Selection Conditions

- Scholarships will be awarded on the basis that the information provided is true and correct.
- TRONPnui and EIT | Te Pūkenga can withdraw the scholarship if the information provided is proven to be inaccurate or incomplete.
- The scholarship must be for study in 2023.
- The decision of the Selection Panel is final.

Selection Process

The Selection Panel will create a **short-list from the information you provide** in the scholarship application, based on the selection criteria identified above. Short-listed applicants may be asked to attend an interview with the Selection Panel.
