

Recycling – Guideline OG220

1. NGĀ WHĀINGA / AIMS

To recycle, reuse and reduce the amount rubbish produced by the Centre.

2. NGĀ RAUTAKI / STRATEGIES

- Adults and children in the centre will research the effects of rubbish on the environment, ways that rubbish can be recycled or up-cycled, and ways that we can reduce the amount of rubbish we produce.
- We will provide activities and resources that help children to learn about recycling and up-cycling our rubbish and the effects of rubbish on the environment.
- We will share information about recycling with our whānau.
- We will provide bins and containers in various areas of the centre to make it easier to recycle eg. all areas where children eat, the art area, kitchen etc.
- We will reuse items where possible eg. yoghurt containers and food boxes in collage, shredded paper for worms, food scraps for worms, chickens, pigs, discard paper cut for art etc.
