

Post-Study Work Visa Checklist

Prior to applying for a Post-Study Work Visa you must obtain a REAL ME account to allow yourself to apply via the Immigration New Zealand (INZ) website.

Go to: <https://www.immigration.govt.nz/new-zealand-visas>

1. Click 'Login'
2. Select visa type
3. Login or create account
4. Create a REAL ME login

Be sure to securely record or remember your login and password for future access

Documents required to apply for a student visa online	Explanation
Fee	\$700.00. You may apply on the computers in the Registry building
Copy of current passport	
Two passport size photos	Head and shoulders. Digital format required (in JPG format)
Evidence of funds – three months NZ bank statement	You are required to have access to \$5,000. Evidence of funds must not be more than three days old at time of application submission
Graduation certificate	Collect from faculty

Police Clearance Certificate (PCC)	https://www.immigration.govt.nz/new-zealand-visas/apply-for-a-visa/tools-and-information/character-and-identity/when-you-need-a-police-certificate
Application submitted within three months of finishing course	

These documents are required to be in a PDF format except for the passport photos which are required to be in a JPG format. This can be done on the EIT Library photocopiers and then emailed to your own email ready to be uploaded to the INZ website
