<sup>\*</sup>Please note an international student in a semester or term-based programme who gains Residency will not receive a refund of fees for the semester or term in which residency is granted. However, they will be treated as a New Zealand Resident for the following semester or term and refunded any international fees paid beyond the semester or term in which residency was granted.

International students in programmes designed with full year non-semester courses must pay the international fees for the full year, regardless of the date Residency has been granted during that year.

If a student requests to defer their study for the semester or term in which his/her residency is granted, they will be required to put in writing notification waiving his/her right to the Residency refund.
